

# O.U.R. Camp

This specialized summer day camp is for young children with developmental needs. Its purpose is to provide continuity with school year programs and to stimulate the development of cognitive and social skills during the summer months. Activities are designed to promote improved self-image and group interaction skills. O.U.R. Camp is licensed by the State of Michigan.

## Camp Sessions 2020

Three sessions are available:

Session 1. June 22- July 9

Session 2. July 13 – July 30

Session 3. August 3 - August 13

Camp sessions are held Monday through Thursday. from 9:30 a.m. to 2:00 p.m.

## Camp Location

The camp is located at Northville Christian\* which is at 41355 Six Mile Road, west of Haggerty and east of Northville Road, in Northville.

*Transportation is not provided.*

## Camp Program

Campers are divided into groups of six and are supervised by two staff members.

Group activities are designed to promote a sense of responsibility, team cooperation skills, and feelings of acceptance. Activities include music, movement, arts and crafts, games and dramatic play to encourage the development of language and motor skills.
